Next working bee:

You are asked to come along on the day. However, if attending is impossible contact the office and you will be billed for this term.

Please note:

- **Please enter the school from Arran St, park on the field and assemble at the library steps at 8:30 so each team can be organised by the team leader.**
- **Please sign the attendance sheet at morning tea time to ensure you don't get a bill for not turning up.**
- Some of you may come in during the week (as arranged through the office). Please notify the office when you come in and we will tick your name off for the Saturday you have been set down for (this needs to be for 3.5hrs). This needs to be organised well in advance of the working bee please.
- These working bees are held to deal with general indoor and outdoor cleaning, tidying and maintenance, etc and can be attended by either the mother or the father, or both.
- Teenage students are encouraged to help also, but not in place of a parent.
- Two families can provide morning tea for the whole group (25-30 people at a guess). Providing morning tea and cleaning up takes the place of doing the working bee. Madeleine Ploeg and Krissy Burns are down for Term 3. We have team leaders in charge of specialist jobs.
- Please check which team you have been allocated to and bring tools in keeping with these jobs. Also check the newsletter the week before the working bee in case additional tools are required. If your skills would be better matched to a different team, please let the office know.
- **Payment for not attending or for being a permanent payer this year is \$120.00 per working bee.**
